Highlights of our future plans are featured below. In addition, due to the high demand for our Toddler and Preschool classes, we are also considering additional classrooms for Toddlers—Elementary to accommodate the needs of our growing student body.

Last year we started the year with 168 students and this year we started with 195. By January 2008, when the 2nd class of Toddlers start and the 3 year olds move up into their reserved spaces in the Preschool classroom, we will be over 215 students.
